- Exams: Two exams will be given throughout the semester as scheduled. Generally, no makeup exams will be given. Calculators are the only aid allowed during the exams.
- Pre and Post-Tests: These tests are intended to test your learning in the course. The pre-test is worth 2% and will be given the first week of class. The post-test is worth 8%. The score for the pre-test is based upon completion of the test. The score on the post-test is based upon the number of correct responses. These tests cover the entire content of the course.

You are to participate in the discussion forums for each article, plus a forum for the movie we will be watching in class. For each of the 4 forums you must contribute at least four comments to each forum. The forums will close at the beginning of class on the dates listed on the Schedule of Assignments.
