Admission to the Teacher Education Program

Admission to Greensboro College is not Admission to the Greensboro College Teacher Education Program. During your first semester of enrollment at Greensboro College you will need to apply for admission into the Teacher Education Program. The State Department of Public Instruction requires this process for both initial and advanced licensures. Applications for admission are available from the Office of Teacher Education, Proctor Hall East, Room 108.

* “Licensure Plus” Program

- Elementary Education (36-44 hours)
- Special Education General Curriculum (33-41 hours)

The Licensure Plus programs are designed for candidates who do not have initial (Standard Professional 1) teacher licensure. These two programs lead to SP1 (initial) licensure. They are available to lateral entry teachers (33-35 hours); candidates who are NOT teaching are required to take an additional 8-hour clinical practicum. After completion of the SP1 (initial) license, candidates may acquire the M.Ed. with the completion of an additional 21 hours in Elementary Education or 24 hours in Learning Disabilities or Behavioral and Emotional Disabilities. Courses will be offered year-round. Exit criteria include a publishable product of learning.
